NCVER: Helping you meet your data reporting requirements



NCVER is the custodian of the national vocational education and training (VET) administrative collections and surveys, on behalf of the state, territory and Commonwealth governments.

- All registered training organisations (RTOs) are required to report all nationally accredited training activity.
- Where you report your data will depend on the respective state or territory arrangements.
- Data can either be sent directly to NCVER or via a state or territory training authority, noting there are some transition arrangements.

The web-based AVETMISS Validation Software (AVS) is the tool through which data is reported to NCVER. Some RTOs may need to use AVS to validate their data or report their data directly to NCVER, but this will depend on the reporting arrangements in your state or territory.
