Reporting reminder: quarter 2

The quarterly collection window covering the period January to June 2019, will be open from **1 to 15 Aug 2019**.

AVETMISS Validation Software (AVS)

There will be a new release of the [AVETMISS Validation Software \(AVS\)](#) at the end of June 2019, with the following update:

- new validation checks where a student is reported to undertake the same training activity multiple times, but with overlapping activity dates. The checks will either trigger errors or warnings depending on reported outcomes.

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USI transcript update tool: 2-day outage (3 to 4 June inclusive)

The USI transcript update tool will be **unavailable** from **3 to 4 June 2019** inclusive for a system upgrade.

Following this upgrade, students' USI transcripts will be updated more quickly, usually within 3 days of submission of data to NCVER (either direct or via an STA submission).
