A number of RTOs were caught out by having to roll back dates in their systems to reflect activity as at 31 December. For RTOs who validated prior to the end of year and only needed to submit their data in the following year, this was not an issue. We recommend all RTOs validate throughout the year to address any issues before the submission window opens in January. This gives our client support team more time to assist with helping you to identify and resolve any errors.

Reporting reminder – quarter 1

AVETMISS Validation Software (AVS)

There will be a new release of the [AVETMISS Validation Software](#) (AVS) at the end of March 2019.

NCVER has improved the quarterly submission process for direct submitters. By default, AVS will now only trigger a warning and not an error when quarterly (Jan–Mar, Jan–Jun, Jan–Sep) submissions contain activity that occurs after the end of that quarterly period.

Note: If you're validating for a state/territory that doesn't accept this activity, you will need to use the *Enforce collection period dates* check box to ensure the system triggers an error where activity occurs after the end of the collection period and (for subjects) isn't resulted as '85 – Not yet started'.
