Early trend estimates – June quarter 2019

Introduction

This fact sheet presents early estimates of apprentice and trainee commencements for the June quarter 2019. Indicative information about this quarter is presented here; the most recent figures are estimated, taking into account reporting lags that occur at the time of data collection.

The early trend estimates are derived from the National Apprentice and Trainee Collection no.100, June 2019. Data are only available for trade/non-trade commencements at the national level and for total aggregated completions (trade and non-trade combined) at the national level. These estimates are then seasonally adjusted and smoothed using X-11 ARIMA methodology, based on data from March 2009 to June 2019. Further information at the disaggregated level for the June 2019 quarter will be released in early December 2019.

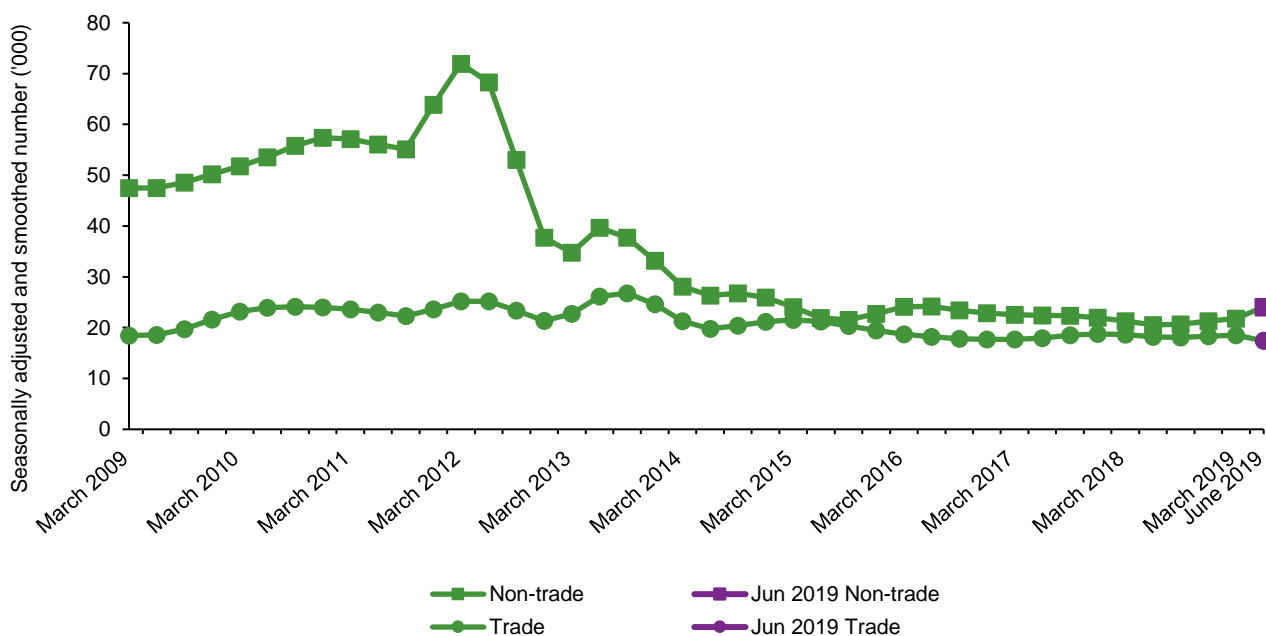
Seasonal adjustment is a statistical technique designed to even out fluctuations in statistics attributable to seasonal influences. Seasonal adjustments provide a clearer view of non-seasonal changes in data that would otherwise be overshadowed by the seasonal differences.

Early trend estimates

Early indications for the June 2019 quarter (table 1):

- Non-trade commencements continue to show an increase from the December 2018 quarter.
- Trade commencements show a decline from the March 2019 quarter.

- Along with commencements it is also possible to estimate an early trend estimate for total aggregated completions (trades and non-trades combined) at the national level. The early trend estimates for completions shows an increase in the June quarter 2019 when compared with the March quarter 2019.

- Notes:
1. Trend estimates are produced by optimally smoothing the seasonally adjusted series. Any referencing of early trend estimates must be done with caution due to the preliminary nature of the submitted data. The submitted data are subject to reporting lags and are updated each quarter. Therefore, results in the trend series are revised quarterly. These revisions affect the most recent four quarters to a much greater extent than the preceding quarters.
 2. Due to the variability of first submission data, these early trend estimates cannot be disaggregated further by state and territory.

These data are compiled under the Australian Vocational Education and Training Management Information Statistical Standard (AVETMISS) for the Apprentice and Trainee Collection specifications, Release 7.0, October 2015.
