AVETMISS reporting

Access to AVS

Change of management? We encourage RTOs to regularly check AVS access and remember to deactivate any AVS users who have left your organisation to ensure that unauthorised USI transcript updates cannot be made.

Superseded training

Outcome identifier 61 - superseded subject is only to be used if your RTO has reported a continuing enrolment from a previous year (*Outcome identifier national 70 - continuing enrolment*) against the old subject code.

Where a subject has been superseded in the *same* year that the student commenced training (or where no activity has been reported) only the new subject code should be used.

USI transcript update tool

The USI transcript update tool is available for adding and/or updating 2022 AVETMISS activity.

This tool cannot be used for training that includes 2023 dates as this data must be reported via your normal reporting method.

The second quarterly collection window for 2023 fee-for-service activity submissions direct to NCVER (covering the period January to June 2023), will be open from 1–14 August 2023.
